- NO CHANGES, CORRECTIONS, OR SUBSTITUTIONS AFTER FEBRUARY 13, 2010.

## Notes to Scouts

- **Class A scout uniform** must be worn.
- Be prepared — have all pre-requirements done.
- Must bring **written or physical proof of completion** for all pre-requirements.
- Bring the **most recent** merit badge book, paper, and pencil for each class (for up-to-date requirements & worksheets see <http://usscouts.org/usscouts/meritbadges.asp>).
- Bring a blue merit badge card, **signed by unit leader beneath your address only**, for each merit badge. Counselors WILL NOT provide merit badge blue cards.
- If a scout is not properly prepared he may be asked to leave the class. The counselor will decide if a partial completion will be issued.
- **Absolutely no registrations, class changes, or scout substitutions will be accepted at the door.**
